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Introduction to Hong Kong College of Health Service Executive (HKCHSE)

The Hong Kong College of Health Service Executives (HKCHSE) was established in 2005, in recognition of the emergence of health service management as a specialty in its own right & to promote the professional advancement of health service management. Formerly it was the Hong Kong Society of Medical Executives which was established in 1990.

Our Mission is **"To achieve excellence in health care service in Hong Kong through the advancement of professional and ethical standards in service management"**. Thus, HKCHSE's membership has attracted a wide spectrum of professional in health and related field.

During the past years, the College has organized lectures, workshops, and seminars on management with themes ranging from management planning to health informatics and health economics. Local as well as overseas experts were invited to be our speakers, giving an interesting blend of international perspectives from China, Singapore, Australia, US and the United Kingdom. From time to time, overseas and mainland study tours are organized to broaden the exposure of our Fellows and members.

Joint conferences were held with the Hong Kong Medical Association on "Financing Health Care in the 1990s -- How Should We Pay?", the Hong Kong Society of Medical Informatics on "Information Technology in Health services" and the Shanghai Hospital Management Society on "Improving Health Services in a Changing Environment". In 2017 the College co-organized with HK College of Nursing and Health Care Management on "Human Resource & Manpower Planning for Healthcare Professional". In 2018, Health Service Management Seminar was co-organized by the College and Macau Health Bureau on "Elderly Care & Home Visit", as well as co-organized with Hong Kong Polytechnic University's College of Professional & Continuing Education on "Quality Health Care for All". Topical conference themes were "Invest in Health, Create Wealth" (2017), "People, Technology and Innovation" (2016), "Sustainability through Innovation" (2015), "Health Care for All: Regional Perspectives" (2014) and "Collaboration for Health" (2013) & etc.

In addition to talks and CPD activities, the College has also organized and delivered a 1-year joint Fellowship program with Australasian College of Health Service Management since 2003. Graduating Fellows are widely recognized both for their professional achievement and career advancement as competent healthcare executives.

The 21st century is a time of challenges and opportunities. It is time for all health service executives and managers to join and strive for a more effective health care delivery system in Hong Kong.

We aim to achieve our vision through the pursuit of the followings: **a) Promoting and enhancing the ethical, academic and professional standards of health service administration and management; b) Promoting research and development activities in the fields of health service administration and management; c) Facilitating networking with other health service associations, whether local or international; d) Participating in local health policy formulation and debates.**

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
